



MIRANDA WARNINGS

You are being asked to make a voluntary statement to federal law enforcement officers who are special agents with TSA Investigations.

You have the right to remain silent and refuse to answer questions at any time.

Anything you say can be used against you in a court of law or other criminal or administrative proceedings.

You have the right to talk to an attorney for advice before answering any questions and to have an attorney with you during questioning.

If you cannot afford an attorney, one will be provided at no cost to you before questioning.

If you decide to answer questions now without an attorney present, you have the right to stop answering questions at any time.

I have read this statement of my rights. I understand the rights that I have. I am willing to make a statement now without an attorney present. I understand and know what I am doing. I have not been made any promises, have not been threatened or coerced, and have not been forced to make this voluntary statement.
