TSA Investigations is conducting an inquiry into matters about which you may have knowledge. This inquiry relates to improper performance of official duties or conduct that may relate to an employee's ability to carry out his or her official duties.

You are being asked to make a voluntary statement to a federal law enforcement officer and special agent with TSA Investigations, who is conducting this interview to obtain information which will assist in the determination of whether administrative action is warranted.

You are going to be asked a number of specific questions related to this investigation.

You have a duty to reply to these questions.

Disciplinary action, including dismissal, may result if you (a) fail to answer, (b) fail to provide all relevant information you have, or (c) make untrue statements.

Neither the statements you make nor any information or evidence obtained from your statements can be used against you in a criminal proceeding, except that the individuals conducting this inquiry are federal law enforcement officers and special agents with TSA Investigations and therefore, if you knowingly and willfully provide false information, you may be prosecuted for perjury or making false statements.

Any statements you make may, however, be used for disciplinary or administrative proceedings.
