

It has been an exciting year. After securing expanded bargaining rights and pay equity in July, due to the hard work of AFGE, including Council 100 and TSA Locals, membership in AFGE TSA increased to place Council 100 as the second largest Council, with over 22,000 members, in the Federation.

Meanwhile, Council 100 continues in constant negotiations with TSA to secure a strong bargaining agreement. At the end of September and mid-November, we hit a large roadblock—a potential government shutdown—which, thanks to all your hard work, including calls to Congress and interviews with media, we were successful in averting. However, that was unfortunately not the end of the seemingly never-ending budgetary saga in Congress. For that reason, we, as leaders, have until early next year to

double down our efforts of demanding that Congress pass a full budget, not another continuing resolution—and we definitely cannot afford a government shutdown. As we fight to ensure our membership receives a solid contract and deserved employee rights, we ask you to stand steadfastly, stay strong, and stick together as we ride out the remainder of this year, where we will emerge tried, true, and ready for the next battle.

CBA UPDATES

On September 30, 2023, AFGE-TSA contract negotiations were extended by agreement between AFGE National President Everett Kelley and TSA Administrator, as a result of an agreed upon continuing resolution, in Congress, which is set to expire on November 17, 2023. Council 100 has opened 30+ articles, much of which have been taken from the CBA survey thousands of our members filled-out in mid-2023. Council 100 is working hard and fast to get as much done as possible, while Congress plays its dangerous game of 'stalemates.' Council 100 has bargained throughout the last four plus months with fiery intention and knowledge that the political environment may not allow for an extended period of bargaining time. Rest assured, your bargaining team is working furiously to ensure our contract is the strongest ever negotiated.

GOVERNMENT SHUTDOWN AVERTED

Thanks to the many TSA Local Unions who stood up, conducted television and media interviews, wrote letters to Congress, rallied at their airports, and educated the public, we were able to avert yet another government shutdown.

Our TSA Siblings from Atlanta and Fort Lauderdale to Fort Worth and Sacramento demonstrated people power by picketing their airports in protest to the government shutdown.

Now, we await the fate of further financial disturbance early next year, as a full budget has yet to pass, but as we always are, we will be ready.
