Effectively immediately, this memorandum is being issued to amend TSA MD 1100.31-1, Trial Periods, as follows:

The basic trial period for all employees shall be one year from the effective date of their TSA appointment without time limitation. Employees on an appointment without time limitation who have completed at least one year of continuous service as of the effective date of this HCAM are considered to have met the requirement for serving a basic trial period. The basic trial period remains one year for veterans' preference (preference-eligible) employees.
